Each Sunday in November holds some type of special event. November 1st is All Saint's Sunday. It's a time to lift up those who have died during 2015, light a candle for them and say some special prayers. God bless all those dear ones who have died and now are with the Lord. November 8th is Veteran's Day Sunday. Veterans Day continues to be observed on November 11, regardless of what day of the week on which it falls. The restoration of the observance of Veterans Day to November 11 not only preserves the historical significance of the date, but helps focus attention on the important purpose of Veterans Day: A celebration to honor America's veterans for their patriotism, love of country, and willingness to serve and sacrifice for the common good. November 15th is the Annual Charge Conference for Liberty Pole UMC and Viroqua UMC. 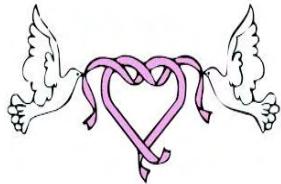
